Article 17 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement for the Jurisdiction of Iron Workers Local No. 387 assigns the adjustment of Wages and Benefits for Apprentice Iron Workers to the Joint Apprenticeship Committee which is comprised of a balance of Management and Union Representatives.

With the tightening of global workforce availability, the Committee Members have reviewed the Apprenticeship Standards and the Compensation Package considering ways to increase the number of candidates available to the contractors performing in the jurisdiction.

In an effort to increase and retain Iron Workers new to the program, the Committee has unanimously agreed to adjust the wage structure for Apprentice Iron Workers. This change will commence at the next scheduled wage increase on 1/1/2023.

Hourly wage adjustment to all period Apprentice Iron Workers as follows:

1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Period Apprentice Iron Workers 60 % of Journeyman Rate  
3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Period Apprentice Iron Workers 67 % of Journeyman Rate  
5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Period Apprentice Iron Workers 74 % of Journeyman Rate  
7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Period Apprentice Iron Workers 81 % of Journeyman Rate

There is no adjustment to the Benefits allocated to the different periods of Apprenticeship.

This adjustment is temporary through 12/31/2023 and may be renewed if the program is successful.
